

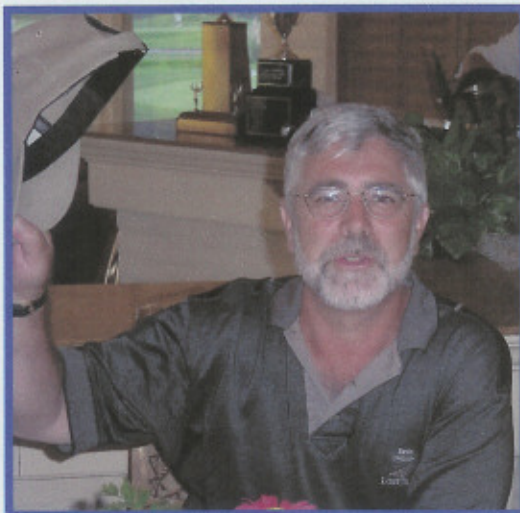
2006 Blue and Gold Captains Announced

Tradition, Competition, Friendship Highlight Picks
